Other Hazards

COMPONENTS

- SKIN IRRITATION -** Remove victim to fresh air and, if needed, immediately begin artificial respiration. Give oxygen if breathing is labored. Get emergency medical help. Contact a physician immediately.
- EYE IRRITATION -** Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if symptoms develop and persist.
- SKIN IRRITATION -** Flush with water or soap and water for 15 minutes or until all traces have been removed. Seek medical attention if symptoms develop and persist.
- INGESTION -** Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth out with water. Get immediate medical attention.

FLAMMABLE - Above 100 F

HAZARDOUS - ND

HAZARD - Approach fire from upwind side. Avoid breathing smoke, fumes, mist or vapors on the downwind side. Firefighters wear protective clothing and self contained breathing apparatus.

HAZARD - Carbon dioxide, water fog or spray.
HAZARD - Smoke, carbon dioxide, carbon monoxide.

COMPONENTS

EMERGENCY RESPONSE - Emergency response coordinator must have mandated training. Eliminate all ignition sources. **SMALL SPILLS:** Pick up with absorbent materials and place in non-leaking containers; seal tightly for proper disposal or reuse. **LARGE SPILLS:** Evacuate the hazard area of unprotected personnel. Wear appropriate respirator and protective clothing. Shut off source of leak if safe to do so. Dike and contain. Remove with vacuum truck or pump to storage/salvage vessels.

LANDFILL - Clean up leaks/spills immediately to prevent soil or water contamination.
AUTHORITY - Notify proper authorities.
